Provision, called a gift over, can be made in the event of, for example, one of your children failing to survive you, the part of your Estate which that child would have inherited can then go to their child/children. A gift does not include the spouse of any of your children. If any beneficiary of your Will is under 20, there is a provision for advances to be made for education, maintenance and welfare.
